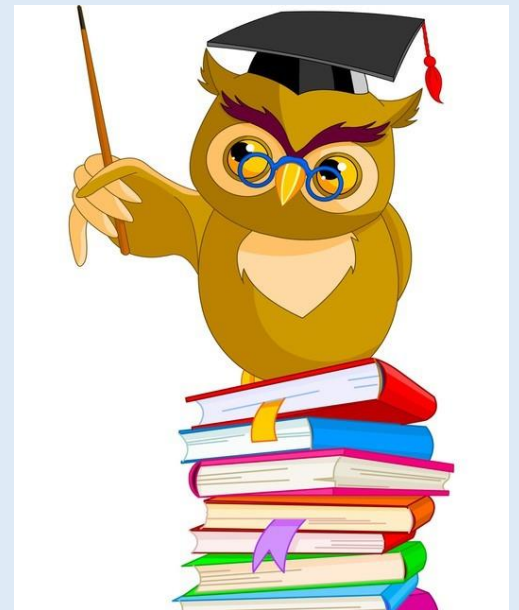

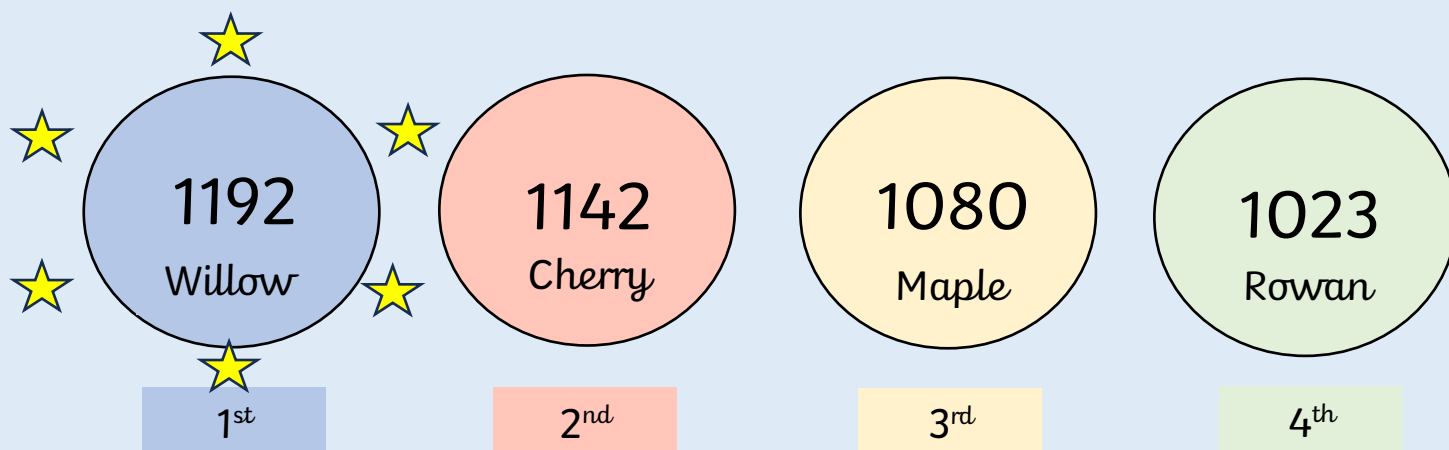

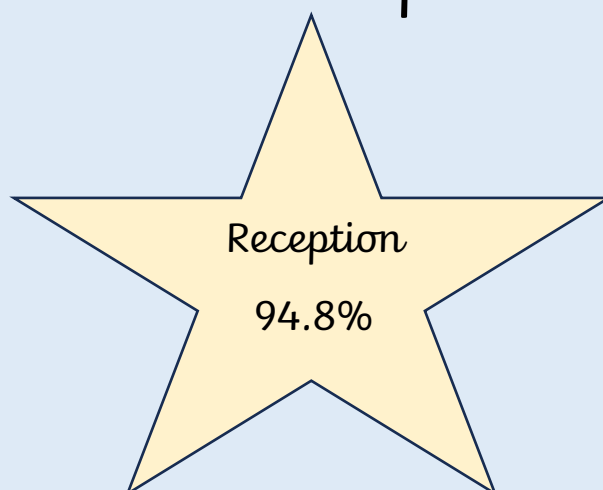

Year 5

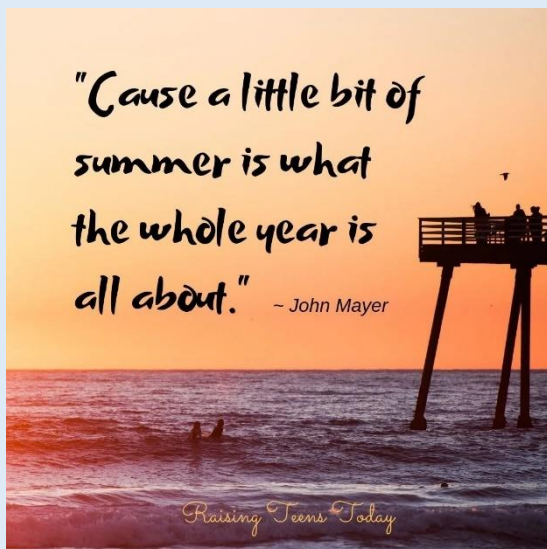
